We arrived August 30 at the house the church has provided for us and found folks waiting to help us unload and a refrigerator and pantry filled with groceries! The first Sunday, Pastor West allowed Joe to preach the evening service as a way for the church to get to know us better, and afterward they had a time of fellowship to welcome us! The following Sunday evening, Joe was able to report (via Zoom) on the recent Scotland trip during the Missions Conference at Oak Grove Missionary Baptist Church of Amherst, OH; we appreciate the encouragement this church has been to us and their giving toward both of our previous missions trips to Scotland!

During the weekdays, we've both been able to help around the church. Joe has begun mapping out the next wave of door to door visitation, as well as working on some missions reports for Pastor West. Joe was also able to assist Bro. Dave in the Bus Ministry by helping to recover seats on one of the busses. Joe's been able to help out with a variety of errands around the church and local area, including helping develop contacts and distribute invitations to the 4th Annual First Responder's Day service (more on that below). Angela's been learning some of the office programs and helping the staff to utilize more of the available features of some of the software. She also helped pack gift bags and assisted the hospitality folks with the First Responder's Day event. Over two dozen department representatives came to the event! More than half a dozen people went forward to learn how to be saved after the service, which was preached by Bro. Mike Pelletier. We praise God for the opportunity to be part of such an important outreach in the community, and how He was able to use it for His glory!
